Announcing Conclave 90

As was decided at Supreme Chapter, Conclave 90 will be held near Atlantic City, New Jersey on January 26-27, 1990. All programming will be done on Saturday January 27. This date was unanimously agreed on at the Supreme Chapter by all Area I Chapters.

Last year we had 194 people showed up at Penn State. This year we should have well over 200 people. We may set a new record for Conclave attendance for a single area !

As always, all Chapters are required to send at least 10 % of their membership to the Conclave (Based on the fall Green Report). You are strongly recommended to sent as many people as possible to the Conclave. Associate Chapters should be sending at least 20 % of their membership to the Conclave.

Here are some specifics:

1. Where: All Conclave programs will take place at Stockton State College in Pomona, NJ on Saturday, January 27, 1990.
Pomona, NJ is located right off the Garden State Parkway or the Atlantic City Expressway near Atlantic City.
2. Cost: \$12.00 per person. Everyone who is preregistered will receive a special gift from your Area Governor.
3. In order to help in ordering food and making other plans for the Conclave, it is important to register your people as soon as possible. Please register by January 15, 1990. You may register part of your people now and others later. If you are not sure who will attend, please send in your check for 10 % or more of your membership. You can send in the names later or add to your totals.
4. Yes you can register at the door but those registering at the door will be ineligible for awards and prizes. Please register in advance !
5. This year's Conclave is Sponsored by Zeta Kappa Chapter at Stockton State College. For your information, they do not have a house.
6. A list of hotels in the Pomona NJ Area is provided. It is much cheaper to stay at these hotels (a few miles outside of Atlantic City) than at a Casino. Social activities planned for Saturday night take us into Atlantic City. Plan on arriving on Friday Night January 26 and leaving Sunday Morning January 28.

7. Please note that these hotels fill up very quickly. You need to reserve a few rooms NOW ! Use a credit card to hold the rooms for late arrival on Friday Night.
8. Agendas and other information will be passed out at the Charlotte Mid-Year Leadership Conference (MYLC). There will be a Special meeting of all delegates attending MYLC with your Area Governor to discuss the Conclave. The meeting will be 5:00 p.m. on January 5, 1990. It is scheduled for the Royce Hotel Ballroom. If your chapter cannot attend this meeting, please notify your Area Governor ASAP so early arrangements can be made to send this information to your Chapter.

10. The Conclave registration fee covers breakfast, lunch, refreshments, materials, handouts, freebies, awards, and some other costs. It does not cover the cost of your hotel rooms.
11. The Chapter that sends the highest percentage of its membership will receive Commemorative Conclave Coffee Mugs.

There will be a special P.U.S.H. program offered during the Conclave.
13. All Chapters are required to bring at least 1 Alumnus to the Conclave.
14. In Addition, all Area Councilors and Chapter Advisors are expected to attend. There will be a special meeting of all alumni on Saturday evening.
15. Bring your Pledges !
16. Registration for the Conclave will start Saturday Morning at 8:30 a.m. at the Stockton State N-Wing, the College Center II. Meals and all programs will take place in this facility.
17. Conclave sessions will run from 8:30 a.m. till 5:00 p.m.
Dress Code is Jacket and Tie for the conclave sessions !
Many of you will want to go to the casinos at night and you will want to look presentable in order to get into the Casinos.
18. Several social activities are planned for Saturday Night.
