CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

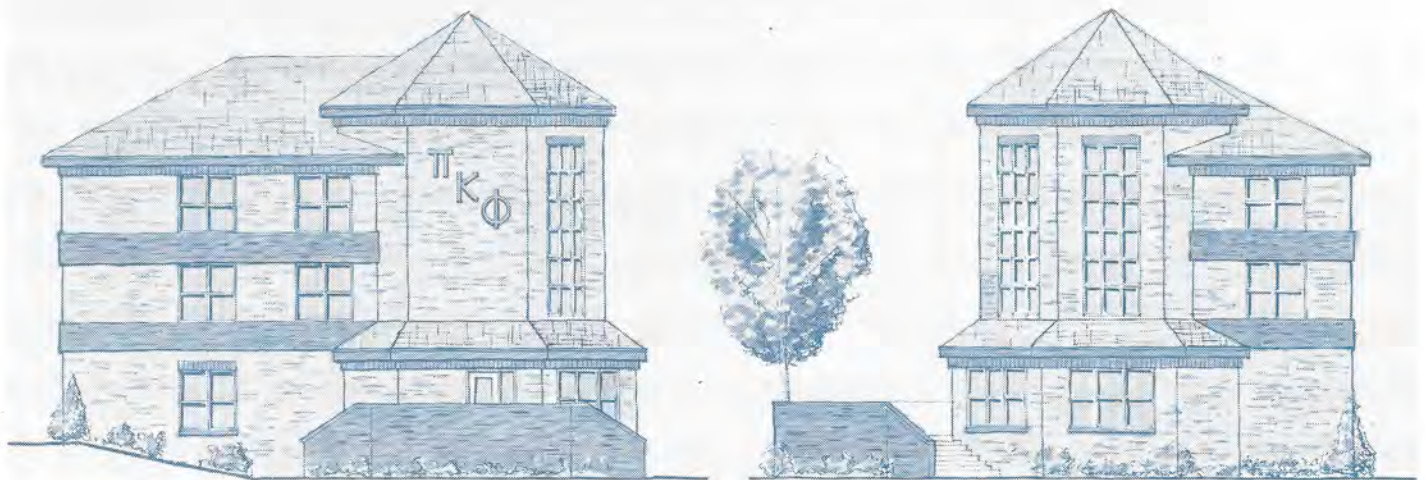
As work continues on the fund raising front, Engineering and Architectural Alumni have joined forces to create the design which will become **Beta Alpha**.
